Steve Beshara: Four Laws of Powerful Presentation Techniques

Former president **Jim Phillips** introduced our speaker, **Steve Beshara**. Steve is the founder and president of Vista Branding, a veteran authority in brand building and cross-platform marketing. He works with a myriad of well-known companies such as Coca-Cola and IBM and for his speech gave a power point presentation with graphics and videos on the "Four Laws of Powerful Presentation Techniques". Those four laws are as follows:



Law #1. The Law of Brevity:

Steve discussed the fact that people have short attention spans. "Less Is More," he reminded us, pointing out that Lincoln's 288-word Gettysburg Address had been preceded by a two-and-a-half-hour speech by another dignitary.

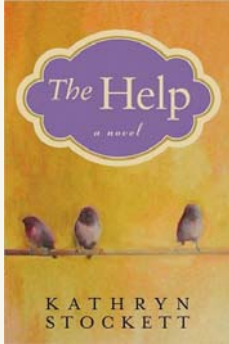
Law #2. The Law of Showing and Telling:

The "Law of Showing and Telling" can help you to avoid a major disaster. The example given to us by Steve was the unfortunate explosion of the space shuttle - when engineers were unable to demonstrate beforehand to Mission Control a simple experiment that O-rings could not hold up to extreme cold temperatures. If they had "Shown and Told", then perhaps this disaster could have been avoided.

Law #3. The Law of Moment Creation:

Steve gave us an example of the "Law of Moment of Creation" by referencing the dramatic courtroom "glove" demonstration in the O. J. Simpson trial. The contention of the Defense that "If the glove doesn't fit, you must acquit." creates a moment that will forever be remembered.
